Training will include Range and Home safety, 22 rifle, 22 pistol, and shotgun training. After training, youth will be allowed to shoot until about 3:00 pm. with a range person supervising one on one. Youth must go thru the training class and be accompanied by a parent or guardian to be allowed to shoot. Youth will shoot sporting clays (shotgun), 22 rifle silhouette targets, 22 pistols at balloons. Bring hearing and eye protection, lunch, and lawn chairs. ALL AT NO COST but must sign up before attending. This will be a great time for youth and a parent or guardian to learn more about gun safety.
